The units in italics are present in varying quantities throughout the war:

**June 1941:** 76mm, 122mm, A/Car

**August 1941:** 76mm

**November 1941:** 76mm, 120mm mortar, Katyusha (very rarely)

**July 1942:** 76mm, 47mm AT, MG Infantry

**December 1942:** 76mm, 47mm AT, AA = 0.

**1943:** 47mm AT gradually replaced with 76/85mm AT. AA = 0.

**1944:** AA=1, E=2 (late 1944)

As the war progresses, the proportion of automatic weapons (sub-machineguns) increases, so that infantry regiments are more likely to have an initiative of 2 (especially in Guards units)

### Infantry Quality:

- June 1941: STR = 3 (-1 due to poor quality)
- August 1941-42: STR = 2 (-2 due to poor quality and small battalions)
- 1943+: STR = 3 (-1 due to small battalions, although some would still get an additional -1 for poor quality)

Other units were often poor quality, especially before 1943, and should get a -1 bonus.

Often units were allowed to run down. Reduced strength units follow the following process:

1. Reduce Infantry Str by 1
2. Remove all units other than the three infantry regiments
3. Reduce Infantry Str by an additional 1

### Guards Units.

Tended to be better quality, larger units, better equipment and had more automatic weapons.

- 1943: Infantry STR = 4. All divisions have 76/85mm AT
- 1944: Infantry STR = 5 (+1 for experienced troops). Allocate one infantry unit an initiative of 2 (SMG).
- 1945: Replace the AT unit with a STR 2 SU 76 unit

**A good way** to represent most Soviet Rifle divisions is with 3 regiments, with one regiment getting a +1 strength bonus (and +1 HE/AT) for the attachment of the divisional artillery to it

In the above example, regiments are -1 for small battalions and -1 for poor training. The first regiment has higher ratings as the divisional artillery is attached to it.

DNO (People's Militia) divisions were formed in Moscow and Leningrad. They were untrained and had no heavy weapons. All were disbanded by 1942.

All have 3 battalions and no regimental cohesion for a basic strength of 3

Strength 2 unit = -1 for poor equipment (represents unit formed from miscellaneous soldiers)

Strength 1 unit = -1 for poor equipment and -1 for poor troops (represents unit with cadre of soldiers, or with high communist zeal)

Strength 0 unit = -1 for poor equipment and -2 for unsuitable troops (represents pressed civilians with no training)

Guards DNO divisions were formed in 1941 from remnants of the original DNO divisions.

They have 3 infantry regiments, all of strength 2.

Mortars are spotted for by the infantry

The Brigades were raised as an expedient unit, easier to produce than an infantry division. By late 1942, many had been converted into divisions or broken up to reinforce divisions.

Troop quality varied, many will be STR 3 or even 2. Often the supporting guns were absent

Mortars are base strength 2 with +1 for good equipment. However, many would receive a -1 for troop quality.

In 1942, the brigade was strengthened – increase infantry STR to 5.

All tanks (apart from flame tanks) and the infantry have received a -1 modifier due to poor troop quality. In theory, the T26 units were being replaced with T34/76 and the T28 with KV1, but this had not happened to most units in June 1941.

The base strength of the tank brigade is 3. A bonus of +1 could be considered for superior equipment and/or the small infantry battalion that accompanied the tanks. However, a -1 bonus could also be considered for poor troop quality. Some brigades were equipped with KV1 instead.

**2nd Half 1942:** A/car unit increasingly present. A very few units have Katyushas

**Early 1943:** A/car, 120mm mortar & SU 76. E=2, AA=2

**May 1943:** A/car, 120mm mortar, 75/85mm AT guns, SU 152. E=2, AA=2.

**August 1943:** A/Car, 120mm mortar, SU 76, SU 122, SU152. E=2, AA=2.

**November 1943:** SU 122, SU 152.

**August 1944:** ISU 122, ISU 152, 76mm. IS II may also be present in some units, where it replaces the ISU 152.

In 1944 T34/76 are increasingly replaced by T34/85

The SP Gun unit is sometimes a different support gun (SU 122, SU 152, etc.)
